Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 8:05 AM in the Eli Mack Room by Chair Susan Ruinen.

November Minutes: Susan Ruinen asked members if there were any corrections or additions to the November minutes. David McGehee made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Rosemary Wilson seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Corley Mill Rd: The committee discussed the plan to relocate Corley Mill Road and the proposed construction of a traffic roundabout. Bob Ferrell made a motion to send a letter to Town Council to express the reservations of the Traffic Committee regarding the proposed plan. David McGehee seconded. The vote was 13 in favor and 1 opposed. (see attached copy of letter).

Signal Timing Old Cherokee: Britt Poole stated that he has not yet received the signal timing report from Carol Jones at SCDOT.

Phase I: Britt Poole told the committee that SCDOT has delayed the projected Phase I start until November. SCE&G should begin utility relocation work in February.

Interchange at I-20 and 378: Work continues on the bid documents for the I-20 Beautification project.

Signal Timing at Northside: Britt Poole reported that SCDOT confirmed damage to the signal loop at the intersection. The repairs have been completed.

Compilation of Plans by COG: The plan compilation has not been received yet.

Caughman at Columbia Ave: The pavement markings at this intersection have not been done yet.

Middle School: Rosemary Wilson will check the status of this problem today.

Susan Ruinen requested committee members email any additions to the agenda for the next meeting.

The next Traffic Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 21, 2012, at 8:00 AM in the Eli Mack Room at the Lexington Municipal Complex, 111 Maiden Lane, Lexington, SC.
