Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 AM in the Eli Mack Room by Chair Susan Ruinen.

April and May Minutes:

Susan Ruinen asked members if there were any corrections or additions to the April minutes. Jay Koon made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Jay Daniels seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Susan Ruinen asked members if there were any corrections or additions to the May minutes. Clyde Smith made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Larry Yon seconded the motion. All in favor, none opposed.

Relocation Corley Mill Rd:

John Fechtel reported that finalized project plans from Lexington One could be completed by July. Susan Ruinen asked if there were public meetings planned. John stated that the final plans will be made public but he had no information on any other meetings. He suggested more information could be obtained from Lexington One as they are the major funding source of the project.

Phase 1:

Britt Poole reported SCDOT should let the project in July. SCE&G has completed most of the electric relocation. The work on relocation of water and sewer lines is on schedule. Construction could begin in late August or September with most work to be done at night. Susan Ruinen asked if mast arms were included in the project. Britt Poole confirmed that three intersections have plans for mast arms.

Insync Signal:

Britt Poole reported that securing funding for the InSync system is close. There are some considerations being studied for the future maintenance of the system. SCDOT has an option to assume maintenance. Dennis Corporation is working to create a template for signal installation when considering plans for future development.

Interchange at I-20 and 378:

Britt Poole reported that the project is continuing.

Compilation of Plans by COG: Britt shared copies of the CMCOG Transportation Study. (attached)

**SC6/Parker Rd/
Middlebrook/Gibson:** There was no update from SCDOT regarding requests for study at these intersections in May. Dan Walker will check on the status.

Swartz Wall: A line of sight complaint was received by the Traffic Committee at the intersection with East Main Street. The retaining wall makes it difficult to see oncoming traffic. There is no easy solution at this time.

Development 378/Hope Ferry: Britt Poole commented that no plans have been submitted at this time. The property owner indicated an interest in combing the parcels.

The Beautification Foundation is working on plans for Main Street including construction of brick planters along the sidewalk and fencing on the island medians.

Bob Ferrell made a motion to suspend the July Traffic Committee meeting and meet next in August. Larry Yon seconded. All in favor, none opposed.

The next Traffic Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 21, 2012, at 8:00 AM in the Eli Mack Room at the Lexington Municipal Complex, 111 Maiden Lane, Lexington, SC.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned on a motion by Larry Yon seconded by Bob Ferrell with unanimous approval by members present.
