L.P.D. OFFERS DRIVE-THRU CHILD SEAT CHECKS

Lexington, S.C. (January 26, 2016) – The Lexington Police Department continues to promote child passenger seat safety with a Drive-Thru Child Seat Check that is scheduled for Wednesday, January 27, 2016.

Child Passenger Seat Technicians will be available from 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. at the front of the Town of Lexington Municipal Building, located at 111 Maiden Lane in Lexington, South Carolina.

Officers, who are also certified CPS Technicians, will be checking to make sure car seats are installed correctly and instruct parents on the best passenger seat types for their child's age and weight range. CPS Technicians will also make sure a car seat has not been recalled or in need of replacement.

Chick-fil-A of Lexington will be providing chicken biscuits and coffee to those who come and have their child's car seat checked.

Chief Terrence Green says that *"We saw a huge response from parents and guardians to the Drive-Thru Child Seat Checks that were offered quarterly in 2015 with over 200 child seats checked through the year. This is a program that is making a difference for families within the Town of the Lexington community and we look forward to continuing it again this year. A child's safety while riding within a vehicle is always important and making sure that their car seat is installed correctly is easy for an officer who is CPS certified to check."*
