### LEXINGTON'S RACE AGAINST HUNGER ROAD CLOSURES, DETOURS & POLLING LOCATIONS

**Lexington, S.C.** (February 22, 2016) – Chief Terrence Green would like to remind residents that the annual Lexington's Race For Hunger will be on the morning of Saturday, February 27, 2016. Those who are traveling within the Town of Lexington during this event may be detoured around the race route or experience momentary road closures.

Lexington's Race Against Hunger will begin and end at the Saxe Gotha Presbyterian Church which is located at 5503 Sunset Blvd. in Lexington.

Road closures and detours will begin along the race route at approximately 7:00 a.m. All affected roadways are anticipated to reopen at approximately 10:30 a.m. Access and exiting from some neighborhoods may also be affected during this race.

Lexington's Race Against Hunger will affect the following roadways:

- Sunset Blvd. from Old Cherokee Road to North Lake Drive
- North Lake Drive from Sunset Blvd. to Main Street
- Harmon Street from North Lake Drive to East Main Street
- East Main Street from Swartz Road to North Church Street
- South Lake Drive from East Main Street to Railroad Avenue
- Maiden Lane
- North Church Street from North Lake Drive to Main Street
- South Church Street from Roberts Street to Main Street
- Gibson Road from Pond View Lane to Hendrix Street
- Roberts Street from South Church Street to Hendrix Street
- Hendrix Street from Roberts Street to South Church Street

Please note that the Democratic Primary is this Saturday and polling stations within the Town of Lexington will be open during the Lexington's Race Against Hunger event. Additional officers and volunteers will be assigned at these locations to assist with voters entering and exiting these polling stations.

The polling stations for the Democratic Presidential Primary will be at the following locations:

- The Harvest Daycare at 501 Whiteford Way
- American Legion Post 7 at 211 American Legion Drive
- Rosenwald Community Learning Center at 420 Hendrix Street

Those registered to vote at the Saxe Gotha Presbyterian Church will now vote at The Harvest Daycare.

Those registered to vote at the Lexington Middle School will now vote at the American Legion Post 7 on American Legion Drive.

Those registered to vote at the Rosenwald Community Learning Center will be able to enter this location from West Main Street to George Street.

Those registered to vote at the American Legion Post 7 can enter this location from East Main Street to Harmon Street to American Legion Drive.

Please note that those attending the Palmetto State Teachers Association conference, which will be held at the Town of Lexington Municipal Complex, should take I-20 to South Lake Drive/Hwy 6 to access parking for this event.
