L.P.D. TRAFFIC DIVISION SAFETY ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES

Lexington, S.C. (February 23, 2016) – The Lexington Police Department Traffic Division will be conducting safety enforcement activities during the daytime hours on Thursday, February 25, 2016 and Friday, March 4, 2016.

The focus of these traffic safety enforcement activities will be on seatbelt compliance and the improper use of the median by drivers at several key intersections where violations have a known history of causing or contributing to traffic collisions.

The locations of focus for these safety enforcement activities will be the following areas:

- North Lake Drive at Columbia Avenue near the Lexington Middle School
- Sunset Blvd. at Old Cherokee Road
- Ginny Lane at Sunset Blvd.
- Augusta Road at Swartz Road

Chief Terrence Green says that *"One part of the Lexington Police Department Strategic Plan is to lower the number of traffic collisions that occur on the roadways within the Town of Lexington. A reoccurring factor in the collisions responded to by our officers is the improper use of the median to pass other vehicles or simply impatience in accessing a turn lane. Staying in your lane until it's lawful to make a lane change will prevent collisions that never needed to happen otherwise."*
