The Lexington Police Department has arrested James Furman Prescott in connection with the traffic collision that occurred on September 13 on West Main Street, which resulted in the death of Brady Davis Weed III. Mr. Prescott, of Lexington, has been charged with "Felony Driving Under the Influence Resulting in Death" and "Reckless Homicide". He is also charged with "Felony DUI Resulting in Great Bodily Harm" due to injuries received by a juvenile passenger in the vehicle.

Chief Green states: "Lab results indicate that Mr. Prescott had synthetic marijuana in his system at the time of the collision. We would like to thank the Lexington County Coroner's Office, the South Carolina Highway Patrol Multi-Disciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT), and SLED for their assistance in this investigation."

Mr. Prescott is currently being held at the Lexington Detention Center awaiting a bond hearing scheduled for 3:00 pm today.
