The Lexington Police Department needs the public's assistance in identifying the driver involved in a hit-and-run accident that resulted in a fatality in the Town of Lexington. At approximately 2:39 AM this morning, a vehicle struck the driver of a moped at Industrial Blvd. and South Lake Drive (S.C. Hwy. 6), and then left the scene. Evidence at the scene indicates that the vehicle involved is a full-size pick-up truck with lights on top, unknown make and color.

The driver of the moped, Hiram Juarez "Rez" Miller, a resident of Lexington and kitchen manager for a local restaurant, suffered severe trauma and was unable to survive the injuries received in the accident.

The Lexington Police Department, with the assistance of the South Carolina Highway Patrol Multi-Disciplinary Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) continues the investigation and will release more information as it becomes available.
