### Suspect in Black Impala Wanted for Auto Break In's

**Lexington, SC** (February 24, 2012, 15:00 pm) – The Lexington Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the unknown individual(s) suspected of multiple vehicle break-in incidents.

On multiple dates an unknown black male subject, believed to be middle aged, has broken into at least seven vehicles which were parked in commercial parking lots along the US 378 corridor of town. The suspect's vehicle is a black Chevrolet Impala (see attached photographs). Chief Terrence Green would like to remind all citizens to "remove all valuables from their vehicles and lock the doors when leaving vehicles unattended. These thieves specifically target electronic devices such as GPS's, laptops, and cell phones as well as purses and bags."
