The 900-seat venue will host various community events including concerts, creating the newest destination for residents and tourists alike to enjoy a night out on the town.

Opening events include Lexington Craft Beerfest on Saturday, October 15, 2016 from 6pm-10pm (tickets can be purchased at www.lexingtonsc.org), and the Town's first **FREE** concert, Downtown Jams on Thursday, October 27 from 6pm-9pm. The event is a family-friendly atmosphere featuring The Root Doctors.

Future development for Project Icehouse includes boutique retail and eateries, boosting the revitalization of downtown Lexington.


“So the Story Goes...”
