MINUTES

TOWN OF LEXINGTON PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING January 18, 2023

The Planning Commission held a meeting on January 18, 2023, at 8:00 AM in the Council Chambers at Town Hall, 111 Maiden Lane, Lexington, South Carolina. The meeting was attended by Chairman Frank Berry, Commissioners Brian Amick, Roscoe Caughman, Jamie Fite, Sammy Hendrix and Joe Robertson. Vice-Chairman Jarett Harrelson, Commissioners Jeannie Michaels and J. T. Stephenson were absent.

<u>CALL TO ORDER & INVOCATION</u>: Chairman Frank Berry welcomed everyone to the meeting. Chairman Berry gave an invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion was made by Commissioner Hendrix and seconded by Commissioner Fite to approve the Minutes from the Planning Commission Meeting on November 30, 2022, as submitted. There was no further discussion. The vote was unanimous in favor.

3. Annexation of Lexington County Tax Map #4300-07-079 Located at 346 Park Road – Action Requested: Recommendation on Zoning and Road Classification

Assistant Zoning Administrator Jessica Lybrand presented the request from The Dowdy Family Trust which owns .69 acres located at 346 Park Road and has petitioned to annex the property. A single-family residence is located on the site. Properties in Town near this one are zoned Protected Residential and Park Road is classified as a Collector Road.

Due to the surrounding conditions and the use of the property the same zoning and road classification is recommended for this property.

Commissioner Amick made a motion to approve as recommended. Commissioner Fite seconded the motion. There was no further discussion. The vote was unanimous in favor.
